Conditions of Entry

1. The Judge has the right to disqualify an entry that does not conform to the Schedule
2. The Judge's word is final
3. All classes judged according to "Point Score". Points for yield and weight will be allotted according to National Booklet
4. No fleece to have more than 12 months' growth
5. All fleeces to be free of skirting belly wool and Contamination. Improperly skirted fleeces will be penalised
6. Ram fleeces eligible in ram wool classes only
7. All entries to be presented in plastic bags, or wool packs clearly marked with the owner's name

1. Super Fine Ewe or Wether Fleece.

a. No points allocated for weight, judged on the following points.

i. Quality.	40
ii. Softness.	20
iii. Spin ability	20
iv. Evenness of length	20
v. Total.	100

2. Superfine Wether or Ewe Fleece

Judged on QUALITY ONLY minimum weight of 2kg

3. Superfine Wether or Ewe Fleece 74's or finer

4. Fine Wether or Ewe Fleece 70's Spinning Quality

5. Medium Wether or Ewe Fleece 64's Spinning Quality

6. Strong Wether or Ewe 60's Spinning Quality

7. Superfine/ fine Ram Fleece 64's / 60's or finer

8. Medium Strong Rams Fleece 64's / 60's Spinning Quality

9. Merino Fleece of highest Commercial Value

10. Comeback Wether or Ewe Fleece 64's / 60's Spinning Quality

11. Fine Wether or Ewe Fleece 58's Spinning Quality
