Conditions of Entry

1. Plastic Green Vases available ONLY. BYO any other vase or bottle
2. Entries may be staged on Thursday Evening by arrangement with the steward
3. The Judge has the right to disqualify an entry that does not conform to the Schedule
4. The Judge's word is final
5. All Exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor except in Floral Art Classes
6. **No exhibitors or spectators are permitted in pavilion during judging**
7. All exhibits to be arranged at the show by the exhibitor
8. All entries in Junior & Juvenile section must be arranged at the show
9. A Novice is someone who has not won a first place in the Open Horticulture section at any agricultural show and does not use any horticulture or floral art as a form of generating their primary income.
10. All Prize money must be collected from the Treasurer Sunday. No prize money under \$30.00 will be posted.

Standard Judging Rules (Australian Dahlia Council)

1. Giant 260mm & over
2. Large 210mm & under
3. Medium 160mm & under 210mm
4. Small 120mm & under 160mm
5. Miniature under 120mm
6. Formal, Informal, Semi Decorative Dahlia, Cactus, Semi Cactus, Exhibitor Cactus, & Fimbriated Dahlia come in all five sizes

7. Ball Dahlia come in small or medium size
8. Pompon Dahlia are under 50mm
9. Waterlily, Collarette, Anemone, orchid, Stellar and Single Dahlias are under 160mm

Judging Definitions

1. X means 1 bloom or cut to a vase
2. XXX means 3 cuts or blooms to a vase
3. NND means “not necessarily distinct”
4. In all cases where the word “DISTINCT” is used it means DIFFERENT
5. A bowl shall is a receptacle, which is wider than its height or which holds less than 1 litre of water
6. A VASE is a receptacle, which is higher than its width or holds more than 1 litre of water
7. In all miscellaneous flower sections, where no standards are specified, blooms shall be shown on stems at least 150mm above the receptacle
8. EMBELLISHMENT means any part of any plant but not another flower
9. ARTIFICIAL ADORNMENT means any manufactured article, such as polished stones, ribbons, drapes, figurines etc.
10. ARRANGEMENT means any container of flower, flowers, foliage and/or berries allowed in the decorative section
11. Formal arrangements may be arranged before commencement of show judging
12. Floral Art, any Embellishments or Artificial Adornments allowed unless otherwise stated
